Brenda serves as Associate Artistic Director for Winnipeg Studio Theatre and helms the StudioWorks Academy & Players programs. She pivoted to two virtual productions during Covid including *Super Happy Awesome News* and *Highlights from Be More Chill*. Her artistic achievements include Winnipeg Theatre Awards (Evie) for Outstanding Educator, YMCA-YWCA's Women of Distinction Award, Rainbow Stage's Wall of Fame and WST's Award of Excellence.
